FAMILY CENTERED SERVICES

The FCS application enables Department of Children and Family Services (DCFS) social workers to connect DCFS children and families with both internal DCFS program resources and contracted services from community partners. The application supports the partnership between DCFS, service providers, and families to connect, coordinate, and address the needs of children, youth, and their families. Programs currently managed within the application include Family Preservation (FP), Partnerships for Families (PFF), Prevention and Aftercare (P&A), and Adoption Promotion and Support Services (APPS). The application allows network service providers to submit invoices that DCFS accounting can process for payment.

- Key features of FCS include:
- Effectively improving operational workflows by enabling the exchange of documents and information among all personnel serving the children
- Efficiently managing and tracking referrals, invoices, and services provided
- Eliminating redundancies and duplication through automation of manual processes
- Providing tools to analyze and view historical data on referrals and services received by children's

Enhancements

The following details each represent a specific enhancement to the Adoption promotion and support services module within FCS.

ADOPTION PROMOTION AD SUPPORT SERVICES

Adoption Promotion and Support Services (APSS) is a federally funded program offering a range of adoption-specific services to stabilize and maintain adoptive placements and finalized homes, prevent disruptions, increase finalizations, and assist children who are hesitant about adoption. APSS strives to ensure permanency for children, foster lifelong relationships and commitments, and boost adoption success. Community-based agencies located throughout Los Angeles County provide free, coordinated services to clients in each Service Planning Area (SPA). The staff at these agencies have expertise in adoption and are trained to focus on adoption-related issues. Families referred by APSS are eligible for individual and family therapy; adoption-focused parenting education; mentors; support groups for children and adults; case management; and connections to services not directly provided by the APSS agency. Caregivers and children are empowered through information, support, and skills to actively participate in guiding their own permanency planning and decision-making.

2. Updates to the APSS Excel Report

The New adoption-related dates have been incorporated into the Excel report in the following Columns:

Column I: First placed with adoptive family date. **Column J:** Adoption Placement Agreement Date.

Column K: Adoption Finalization Date **Column L:** Adoption Removal date

Column M: Termination of Parental Rights Date

Column N: TPR Appealed

3. Terminology Update

The term **TDM** had been replaced with **CFT** throughout the module.

4. Wording Correction

The word "Perspective" has been corrected to "Prospective" to align with appropriate adoption terminology.

5. Ethnicity dropdown Enhancements

Two new ethnicity selections have been added, and the complete list has been alphabetized for consistency and ease of use:

- Multiples two or more
- Other Not Listed

6. Email Notification Update

Email notifications now include the child's last name and initial, allowing staff to identify the child's reference in the referral while still protecting PII.
